### 3. Admin Report - Stephen Koshurba

### **School Updates:**

- Enrolment numbers continue to stay steady, with a slight increase in registrations this
  month
- Board technology funding has allowed us to purchase 20 new Chromebooks and 5 iPads.
- We have 71 devices (31 Chromebooks and 40 iPads) that are no longer up to date and will be returned to the board. The new purchase made will help off-set the loss of these devices at the end of the year
- The technology plan will be to invest the 2025/26 technology money into more Chromebooks and iPads.
- Kindergarten and grade 1 will use iPads Grade 2 through 8 will have access to Chromebooks
- The School Climate and Document Review Working Groups met last month and outlined a school climate action plan, along with creating an updated CODE of CONDUCT, Progressive Discipline Model, and Discrimination Policy. The work done in these groups lay the foundation for work that will need to be taken on by our Positive School Climate Team.

#### **November Actions:**

- Progress Reports will be coming home on Wednesday, November 20th
- o Interviews: Between now and the Winter Break, classroom teachers will be reaching out to offer the opportunity to meet with them either in person, by phone, or virtually
- o November staff meeting focus will be the Principles of Indigenous Education. Our board's Indigenous Ed. Consultant will be leading this work with staff
- November is Indigenous History Month learning about treaties has been a focus of learning. The first Indigenous Learning Circle was hosted by Ms. Walas, and Ms. Brown with another session already planned.
