3. Admin Report:

School Updates:

- Enrolment for current sits at 412 students. We continue to have some capacity in the building
- We service 3 regional LLS programs with the space for 5 more students
- First PD Day focus: Literacy and Math developing the school action around improving outcomes in both areas
- October PD day Focus on Mental Health and our School Improvement planning
- TFPS has been selected as an NVCI pilot project for training all teachers on a program that supports managing student well-being within the classroom. (T Fox has the largest LLS program & the most support staff)
- Technology budgets for 2024/25 school year have not been provided at this time. We are looking to prioritise the purchase of student Chromebooks and iPads.
- The TFPS library is focusing on the development of an EDI, and Indigenous Ed. Teacher resource collection. This will include books, teaching materials, lesson plans, and resources to support planning for students.

October Actions:

- Individual Education Plans (IEPs) for all students with specific programming needs will be sent home no later than October 15th
- Harvest Games is a TFPS community building initiative that brings classes and divisions together in play and friendly competition. This will happen Friday, October 11th.
- TFPS School Climate Working Group meeting on Friday, October 18th.
 This is a group of staff that will look closely at our vision, mission, and actions through the lens of inclusion and belonging (i.e., "How do we want our students, staff, families, and communities to feel?")
- TFPS Document Review Working Group meeting on Thursday, October
 24th . Review our policies, systems, and responses through multiple lenses to

- create a transparent and actionable plan for supporting the TFPS community going forward. This too is a group of staff.
- The goal of both working groups is to create the basis for the Positive School Climate Team. This group will meet monthly starting in November. Viki has already come forward as a SCC rep. Others who are interested are still encouraged to participate.
